TREES



Flame Thrower™ Redbud

Cercis Flame Thrower™ 'NC2016-2' PPTBS

Bred by Dr. Denny Werner in North Carolina and introduced by Star Roses and Plants.

This breakthrough small tree variety has extremely unique foliage color, with four to five different foliage colors (burgundy, red, orange, yellow, lime) on just one branch. New growth is burgundy/red and ages to bright yellow, then green. Very minimal leaf scorch, and low maintenance. Semi-pendulous habit, growing to 15-20 feet high and 15 feet wide. Prefers full sun. Hardy to Zones 5-10.

Available as bare root from Star Roses and Plants (Booth 16007).



Golden Falls™ Redbud

Cercis Golden Falls™ 'NC2015-12' PPAF

Bred by Dr. Denny Werner in North Carolina and introduced by Star Roses and Plants.

Gold leaf weeping form is a new color for *Cercis*. Derived from 'Hearts of Gold', this *Cercis* has little to no leaf scorch and is low maintenance. New growth is tinged with orange that eventually turns golden yellow to lime green. Great for small yards and spaces. Pink flowers in spring. Grows to 8-10 feet tall and 3-4 feet wide. Prefers full sun. Hardy to Zones 5-10.

Ruby Dayze™ Crabapple

Malus 'JFS KW139MX' PPAF

Selected by Keith Warren from the crabapple breeding program of J. Frank Schmidt & Son Co. and introduced by J. Frank Schmidt & Son Co.

Ruby Dayze™ Crabapple earns high marks in all of the important performance categories for ornamental crabapples. A profuse crop of bright magenta-pink flowers attracts pollinators and is followed by clean, highly disease-resistant, purple-red foliage. Leaves mature to bronze-green in late summer and presents orange-red in autumn. Tiny, deep red fruit persists into winter. Growers and landscape managers appreciate its disease resistance and low-maintenance, upright, tightly oval form. Fruit is remarkably small. Bloom is very heavy, smothering its branches in springtime. Improved disease resistance, symmetrical branch habit and tighter, more oval form makes it a good replacement for a host of standard crabapple cultivars. Upright, oval form presents a flowering crabapple suitable for street tree planting. Hardy to Zone 4.


Winecraft Gold™ Smokebush

Cotinus coggygria Winecraft Gold™

and Proven Winners® ColorChoice®.

This improved gold smoke bush is a better, more vigorous production plant with good burn resistance. Better branching creates a denser, fuller shrub for better presentation in the container and the landscape. Green flowers in early summer age to the pink smoke-like puffs that give this plant its common name. The gold foliage has better burn resistance. Compact growth habit, reaching heights of 4-6 feet. Zones 5-8.

It was selected for its low growing, prostrate habit which is unique among the *Distylium* cultivars on the market. Its blue-green leaves are densely arranged on horizontal branches. Like all First Editions® *Distylium*, Swing Low is an adaptable plant that can be used in multiple landscape applications. It adapts well to pruning and is disease- and insect-resistant. Reddish-maroon flowers in late winter to early spring. Grows moderately fast in full sun to part shade. Zones 7-9.

Double blooms, deer-resistant, drought-tolerant, heat-tolerant and salt-tolerant. Can be grown as a standard or shrub. Reaches heights of 8-12 feet and widths of 6-10 feet. Zones 5-9.

The blooms are offset with fantastic deep-green foliage and the stems are very strong to hold up the 10-inch blooms. As a tetraploid, this plant is stronger and tougher with thick stems and strong, deeply colored, leathery foliage and long-lasting blooms. Flowers in spring and summer, with an ultimate size of 3½ feet tall and 3 feet wide. Makes a statement in the garden or as an entryway accent in a container. The blooms hold their color for an extended period of time and make excellent dried flowers. The compact habit without the use of PGR fits usefully into a variety of smaller spaces in the landscape. Zones 4-9.

Iceberg Alley™ willow is an exciting native plant discovered by the Memorial University of Newfoundland and Labrador Botanical Garden. The powdery, silver foliage of this small shrub will be a great addition to the landscape, adding texture and contrast when combined with other colorful foliage shrubs. The slower growth and round form does not overtake the landscape, reaching a height and spread of about 3-6 feet. It blooms in spring with a very pretty silver and yellow catkins with red stamens that can be cut for early spring decoration. Best in full sun and moist soils. Despite being from maritime Canada, it has proven adaptable to the cold, performing well at Jeffries Nursery (co-introducer) in Manitoba, Canada as well the humidity of the Midwest at Bailey test sites in Minnesota and Illinois. More compact than the species. Zones 2-6.

This beauty is a seedling selection from *Vitex trifolia* 'Purpurea' × *V. agnus-castus* that combines the best of both parents. Flip Side® is cloaked in 8-inch panicles of fragrant, deep purple flowers that attract a nonstop parade of pollinators. It's also a strong rebloomer. Flip Side got its name because the greyish olive-green leaves are dusky purple on the lower surface providing a splash of color on breezy days. It grows rapidly to form an upright, arching shrub 6–8 feet tall and 8–10 feet wide. Easy to grow and best in full sun. While *V. trifolia* 'Purpurea' is only hardy to Zone 9, Flip Side has been hardy in Athens, Georgia for a number of years, surviving a Zone 7 winter. It has also shown potential as a sub-shrub in Zone 5b at Bailey's central Illinois location, growing to about 4 feet tall and wide and blooming in mid-late summer to frost. Zones 7–9.

Blooms heavily from late spring to early summer. This species was selected for overall plant health, long-lasting foliage, dark green leaves, and dark flower color. Naturally disease- and drought-resistant. Grows best in a loamy soil and provided supplemental moisture. True native, dark green leaves, dark pink flower, compact growth and prolific bloom. Full sun to part shade. Zones 4-8.

Impatiens walleriana

Collaborating on the project was a team in The Netherlands, led by breeder Ruud Brinkkemper, and a crew in the United States consisting of product manager Lisa Lacy, plant pathologist Dr. Colleen Warfield, and many others. Available in six colors and two mixes, you can fill baskets, window boxes, and shade landscapes with confidence. Beacon™ is easy to grow. It has the same plant structure, flowering time, flower size and culture as traditional garden *Impatiens*. Mature plant height can be 10-12 inches (25-30 centimeters) and width can be 12-14 inches (30-36 centimeters). Beacon has been proven with high resistance to IDM from sowing all the way through the gardening season. Shade.

Everglow® Sedge

Carex morrowii 'Everglow'

Bred/selected by Pat Fitzgerald, Fitzgerald Nursery, Kilkenny, Ireland, and introduced by Fitzgerald Nursery.

Graceful upright, arching blades feature a rich green center flanked by white stripes with a tinge of orange, turning an attractive orange-gold as the foliage matures. In late fall and winter the entire plant is sunset orange. A great border plant for edging or massing. Also effective in containers, alone or in combos. Grows best in moist, well drained soils in sun or part shade. Vigorous but controlled growth. 19 inches high and wide. Deer-tolerant. No serious pests or diseases. *Carex* 'Everglow' is the latest addition to the popular Evercolor® series. Its blades feature a color combination unlike any other in this very varied, grass-like genus. Zones 6-9.


