

PERENNIALS



Realflor® 'Real Goldcup' Leucanthemum

Leucanthemum superbum 'L1209-1'

Bred by Richard Read of U.K.-based Realflor For Plant Haven and introduced by Sunset Plant Collection.

This stunning new Shasta daisy has long-lasting, large, bright yellow blooms. The blooms are colorfast with no color phasing, and the flowers have bold golden yellow centers carried on very strong stems. This variety is very floriferous, with improved disease resistance. It is an excellent garden performer, and the sturdy stems make it ideal for cut flowers. Grows to 36 inches high by 18 inches wide; deer and disease resistant. Low water use once established. Prefers full sun. Zones 5-9.

Beyond Pink'd™ Bluebeard

Caryopteris incana 'DCARBEBYBAR' USPPAF

Developed by Gavriel Danziger, Danzinger Dan Flower Farm in Moshav Mishmar Hashiva, Israel, and introduced by Spring Meadow Nursery and Proven Winners ColorChoice Flowering Shrubs.

Beyond Pink'd™ has the darkest pink flowers on the market. The mature height is 2-2.5' tall and 2-2.25' wide. Beyond Pink'd is a very compact grower, bearing brilliant sprays of dark pink flowers throughout the summer. Long-bloomer, attracts pollinators and deer resistant! Prefers full sun. Zone 7b.

BODACIOUS® Hummingbird Falls Salvia

Salvia × guaranitica '#2017-0032'

Bred by Kermit Carter at Flowers by the Sea in California, and introduced in collaboration by Dümmer Orange and PlantHaven International.

Salvia BODACIOUS® Hummingbird Falls is the first *Salvia guaranitica* bred for hanging baskets or the very front of the flower border. It has a unique, compact mushroom habit. It has large, saturated dark blue blooms with striking black calyx, and compact, 4-inch flower stems. It is ideal for 8-10-inch baskets, containers, garden borders, and mass landscape plantings. Prefers full sun. Zones 7-8.

Available as unrooted cuttings and plugs from McHutchison (Booth #18046).

SHRUBS

Paraplu Rouge™ Rose of Sharon

Hibiscus syriacus 'Minsyrou17' USPPAF, Can PBRAF

Bred by Minier Nursery in France and introduced by Spring Meadow Nursery and Proven Winners ColorChoice Flowering Shrubs.

The Paraplu Series offers the consistent theme of unique colors and large flowers. For Rouge this is especially so, because its color is the closest to red on the market for hibiscus. Paraplu Rouge's mature height is 6-10 feet tall and 5 feet wide. It has large reddish pink flowers, and a graceful habit that moves in the breeze. It is not stiff and awkward like other roses of Sharon. Thanks to their naturally graceful habit, Paraplu roses of Sharon don't require much pruning. Prefers full sun. Zone 5.

Aquavita™ Juniper

Juniperus virginiana 'FARROWJVB' USPPAF

Bred by Mark Farrow in Maryland, and introduced by Spring Meadow Nursery and Proven Winners ColorChoice Flowering Shrubs.

Aquavita is attractive because it is an easy grower. It is both more natural and graceful than 'Blue Arrow'. This aqua-blue pyramidal juniper caught our attention for its color and kept us hooked with its elegant narrow habit. If you're familiar with 'Blue Arrow', Aquavita has a more natural-looking, filled in shape. Excellent deer resistance and low maintenance nature make it a perfect fit for any garden, as a specimen, screen, or hedge. Aquavita mature height is 12-15' and the mature width is 3-4' it is very adaptable and offers beautiful aqua-blue color. Prefers full sun. Zone 4.

NewGen Independence® Boxwood

Buxus 'SB108' PP28888

Discovered as a chance seedling by a boxwood enthusiast in the Williamsburg, Virginia area and introduced by NewGen® Boxwood, Saunders Genetics LLC.

NewGen Independence® was chosen for the NewGen brand based on very high tolerance to boxwood blight as well as outstanding performance in boxwood leafminer trials.



It has habit similar to *Buxus microphylla* 'Green Beauty' but has much better Boxwood Leafminer resistance and the leaves are slightly more elongated. NewGen Independence is a very deep green, medium sized cultivar that holds excellent color throughout the winter. It has a rounded habit that is nearly as tall as wide. NewGen Independence can be used in formal plantings where a medium sized round plant is desired. Branching structure is very strong allowing it to withstand most moderate to heavy snow loads. Deer resistant. Great boxwood for formal and classic boxwood look. Prefers full sun. Zones 5b-8.

NewGen Freedom® Boxwood

Buxus 'SB300' PP32421

Found as a mutation by J. Bennett Saunders at Saunders Brothers Inc., Piney River, Virginia, and introduced by NewGen® Boxwood, Saunders Genetics LLC.

NewGen Freedom® was selected due to its better resistance to Boxwood Blight and resistance to Boxwood Leafminer. The habit is more uniform and tighter than 'Wintergreen' or 'Winter Gem'. NewGen Freedom is a relatively vigorous, rounded cultivar that is slightly taller than wide, with beautiful glossy medium green foliage — perfect for formal plantings or as a specimen. Its vigor helps create an attractive plant quicker than many cultivars but also makes annual pruning a must. Deer resistant. Prefers full sun. Zones 5-8.

Kimono™ Hydrangea

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Hokomareki' USPPAF

Hybridized in The Netherlands by Kolster BV and introduced by Curoplant Co.

Kimono™ sets a new standard for reblooming macrophylla hydrangeas. Its combination of heavy reblooming, compact size, dark foliage and flower coloration is unique and improved over novelties released in recent years. Dazzling blooms of white and pink florets with red margins sit atop dark green foliage, all wrapped into a compact 2-3-foot package, suitable for the modern outdoor space. Prefers part sun. Zones 5-8. (Photo by Bloomin' Easy®.)

First Editions® Little Hottie® Panicle Hydrangea

Hydrangea paniculata 'Bailpanone' PP32549

Bred by Bailey Innovations in Athens, Georgia, and introduced by Bailey Nurseries.

Little Hottie® panicle hydrangea brings a genetic compact size and heat tolerance to the crowded *H. paniculata* marketplace. This cultivar went through years of trials to ensure it could really hold up to the heat, as well as maintain its compact size. The basal branching structure provides ease of maintenance, reducing the ongoing pruning needed to maintain shape, form, and branch structure. Little Hottie has very full flower heads with florets that emerge green and turn sparkling white. This well-branched, compact panicle hydrangea is covered in large blooms from the bottom to the top of the plant and holds tight flower clusters out on strong stems. Flowers don't get heat-stressed or turn brown in excessive heat. Fall color is soft pink. Prefers part sun. Zones 3-8.

First Editions® Cool Glow® Peach Nandina

Nandina domestica 'ZhNan28' PPAF

Bred at the University of Georgia in Athens, Georgia and introduced by Bailey Nurseries.

One of three new introductions in the First Editions® Shrubs & Trees Cool Glow collection, Cool Glow Peach Nandina has sparse seed set and has unique fall and winter color with shades of peach and apricot. Its compact size is also a fantastic characteristic for this shoulder season hot item. Shades of peach and apricot fall and winter color compliment the other colors of Nandina in this series. Cool Glow Peach has lacy dark green foliage that is incredibly attractive throughout the year with a well behaved, compact habit and sparse seed set. It is adaptable to a range of soil types, including dry conditions. It is moderately fast growing, forming dense upright mounds that are ideal for foundation and mass plantings. Prefers full sun. Zones 6-9.

First Editions® Vanilla Brandy Abelia

Abelia 'Bailbeliaone'

Discovered by Bailey Innovations and introduced by Bailey Nurseries.

Vanilla Brandy's variegated leaf that retains that color throughout the season is unique and stands out in the landscape. The ease in production is also a great benefit to this new cultivar. This tight, compact *Abelia* has green leaves with white margins that hold their color without necrosis from sun and heat. In the fall, leaf margins turn pink to rose. Leaves are evergreen to semi-evergreen. The flowers are white, about 1 inch long, and slightly fragrant. Flowers open in May-June and continue through October. Sepals turn pink and are persistent. New stems are red-purple through the growing season and add to winter interest. Vanilla Brandy is a good production plant. It doesn't lean or flop in containers and roots to the bottom. Plants are uniform and don't need pruning to stay compact. Prefers full sun. Zones 6-9.

Center Stage™ Coral Crapemyrtle

Lagerstroemia indica 'SMNLIJ' USPPAF

Bred by Megan Mathey at Spring Meadow Nursery and introduced by Spring Meadow Nursery and Proven Winners ColorChoice Flowering Shrubs.

A cut above! The Center Stage series only lets in trialed and tested winners and this new addition is proof. For Center Stage Coral, as well as the rest of the Center Stage series, the breeding focus was to develop crape myrtles with an earlier bloom date and mildew resistance. Earlier blooms, richer intense reddish-black foliage, and less prone to mildew. You'll love the ruffled, fully saturated coral flowers and healthy, rapid growth too! Mature height and width will be 6-12 feet tall and 8 feet wide. The other varieties in the series are Center Stage Red and Center Stage Pink. Prefers full sun. Zone 7.

Pink Myst® Cherry

Prunus sargentii 'JFS KW21PS'

Developed in the J. Frank Schmidt & Son Co. New Plant Development Department by plantsman Keith Warren, who identified it as an outstanding seedling of the popular Pink Flair® Cherry, and introduced by J. Frank Schmidt & Son Co.

Pink Myst® is narrower in form than most ornamental cherry species and cultivars, including columnar Sargent cherry. It has darker pink flowers, clean foliage and superior resistance to typical cherry diseases including bacterial canker and gummosis, even where wet springtime climates are problematic for flowering cherries. Its bright pink flowers, darker in color than other Sargent cherry blooms, smother the branches of this unique cultivar that is also narrower and more upright and oval in form than is typical of the species. The cultural requirements for this adaptable, urban-tolerant tree are the same as for the species. Its narrow slender form makes it a good fit for city street plantings and home gardens where space is limited. Rich, dark green foliage stays fresh and clean through the summer months and turns to lovely shades of orange and red in autumn. Mature height and spread are approximately 30 feet by 15 feet. Prefers full sun. Zone 4.

Snow Crystal™ Crabapple *Malus* 'JFS KW218MX'

Hybridized in the J. Frank Schmidt & Son Co. crabapple breeding program and selected by plantsman Keith Warren as a superior white-flowering cultivar, and introduced by J. Frank Schmidt & Son Co.



Snow Crystal™ offers excellent resistance to typical crabapple diseases including scab, fireblight, cedar-apple rust and mildew. Its tiny persistent fruits are smaller than most of the yellow-fruited cultivars. Its compact, dense, uniform canopy gives a formal look that is atypical of most ornamental crabapples. Its bright white flowers open from pink buds to smother the branches of this densely branched, symmetrical tree in spring. Blooms are followed by dark green leaves that accentuate its distinctively compact, pyramidal form throughout the growing season. Tiny (¼-inch) yellow to golden orange fruits take the four-season show into the winter months. Perfectly suited for use as a small ornamental, all-season ornamental flowering tree for home gardens and yards. Its symmetrical, pyramidal form earns it a place on our UtiliTrees™ list of trees suitable for use beneath utility lines and in the narrow space between street and sidewalk. Pollinators are attracted to clouds of single, snow-white flowers, and birds appreciate its bountiful crop of persistent fruits. Bonus reasons to choose this exceptional new cultivar include excellent resistance to the typical diseases that affect crabapples, plus a distinctively compact canopy that reaches a height and spread of 15 feet tall and 12 feet wide. Prefers full sun. Zone 4.
